Support sought: budget and motivation

As in all sports, financing a squash season represents a significant cost. The year 2026 is distinguished by Corentin's participation in the Individual Junior World Championships in Canada, with Alice Allard (Belgian Junior Champion 2026 GU19 and European top 20 GU19) and Annabel Romedenne (coach).

The budget for a typical squash season exceeds €10,000, split in

- Travel (5-6 international competitions, national competitions and training): 4,000 - 5,000 €
- Registration and accommodation in international competitions: 3,000 - 4,000 €
- Training sessions: 2.000 - 3.000 €
- Equipment and outfits (excluding equipment support): €500.

In addition, there are the costs of participating in exceptional events such as the 2026 World Championships in Canada or high-level training (master classes, stays with high-level coaches, etc.)

Corentin has obtained initial material support from the equipment manufacturer Dunlop for the period from May 2024 to July 2026.

Nevertheless, existing financial support has sharply *fallen* sharply:

- The Walloon support programme (approx. €3,000 / year) was stopped in 2025 (for all athletes)
- LFS has few resources and no longer receives, since the 2025-2026 season, automatic financial support for young people from Adeps.

Corentin is therefore looking for recurring or one-off support to finance each squash season in addition to his family's intervention.

- by specifically supporting the participation of Corentin, Alice and Annabel in the 2026 Junior World Championships
- by supporting one or more of Corentin's sports seasons.
